The shares of Common Stock registered on this Registration Statement with respect to the 2009 Non-U.S. Plan consist of 4,000,000 shares authorized for issuance under the 2009 Non-U.S. Plan as approved by the stockholders of the registrant on June 2, 2010. Following the registration of the shares registered hereby, there will be an aggregate of 8,700,000 shares of Common Stock registered and authorized for issuance under the 2009 Non-U.S. Plan.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This registration statement is being filed by the registrant, NeoStem, Inc. (the “Company”) pursuant to General Instruction E on Form S-8 (Registration of Additional Securities), for the purpose of registering 17,950,000 additional shares of the Company’s common stock, par value \$0.001 per share (“Common Stock”), which may be issued with respect to awards under the NeoStem, Inc. 2009 Equity Compensation Plan (the “2009 Plan”) and the NeoStem, Inc. 2009 Non-U.S. Based Equity Compensation Plan (the “2009 Non-U.S. Plan”).

The 17,950,000 additional shares of Common Stock are being registered hereby in connection with: (i) an amendment to the 2009 Plan increasing the number of shares of Common Stock authorized for issuance pursuant to the 2009 Plan by 5,950,000 shares, from 3,800,000 shares to 9,750,000 shares, as approved by the Company’s stockholders at a special meeting of stockholders held on October 29, 2009; (ii) an amendment to the 2009 Plan increasing the number of shares of Common Stock authorized for issuance pursuant to the 2009 Plan by 4,000,000 shares, from 9,750,000 shares to 13,750,000 shares, as approved by the Company’s stockholders at the annual meeting of stockholders held on June 2, 2010; (iii) an amendment to the 2009 Non-U.S. Plan increasing the number of shares authorized for issuance pursuant to the 2009 Non-U.S. Plan by 4,000,000 shares, from 4,700,000 shares to 8,700,000 shares, as approved by the Company’s stockholders at the annual meeting of stockholders held on June 2, 2010; and (iv) an amendment to the 2009 Plan increasing the number of shares of Common Stock authorized for issuance pursuant to the 2009 Plan by 4,000,000 shares, from 13,750,000 shares to 17,750,000 shares, as approved by the Company’s stockholders at a special meeting of stockholders held on January 18, 2011.

Following the registration of the shares registered hereby, there will be (i) an aggregate of 17,750,000 shares registered and authorized for issuance under the 2009 Plan and (ii) an aggregate of 8,700,000 shares registered and authorized for issuance under the 2009 Non-U.S. Plan.

The contents of the earlier registration statements (File No. 333-159282 and File No. 333-162733) are hereby incorporated by reference and made a part hereof, except to the extent as amended hereby.

All documents subsequently filed by us with the Securities and Exchange Commission pursuant to Sections 13(a), 13(c), 14 or 15(d) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as amended (the "Exchange Act"), prior to the filing of a post-effective amendment to this registration statement, which indicates that all securities offered hereby have been sold or which deregisters all securities then remaining unsold, shall be deemed to be incorporated by reference in this registration statement and to be a part hereof from the date of filing of such documents.

In the event that a claim for indemnification against such liabilities (other than the payment by the registrant of expenses incurred or paid by a director, officer or controlling person of the registrant in the successful defense of any action, suit or proceeding) is asserted by such director, officer or controlling person in connection with the securities being registered, the registrant will, unless in the opinion of its counsel the matter has been settled by controlling precedent, submit to a court of appropriate jurisdiction the question whether such indemnification by it is against public policy as expressed in the Securities Act and will be governed by the final adjudication of such issue.
