Corniche Group Incorporated (the "Company" or "Corniche") is not able to file its Quarterly Report on Form 10-Q for the quarter ended September 30, 2002 (the Form 10-Q) within the time period prescribed for such report without unreasonable effort or expense.

As previously reported, the Company had entered into a Stock Contribution Exchange Agreement pursuant to which control of Corniche would have passed to the principal shareholders of StrandTek International, Inc. ("StrandTek"). A closing of the transaction with StrandTek did not occur and the Agreement has been terminated. StrandTek has defaulted in repayment of a \$1.25 million obligation to the Company. This has impeded the Company in preparing its Form 10-Q for the quarter. The Company anticipates filing its Form 10-Q within the next five calendar days.
